<p>English If you choose to do the information report it is worth two activities!</p>	<p>Write an Information Report on a topic that interests you. Please include a heading, introduction, sub-headings, and a conclusion. You may also include diagrams, pictures and photos. You can present this in an interesting way such as a poster, powerpoint or booklet.</p>	<p>Write 5 interesting sentences and then circle the nouns green, underline the verbs red, and tick the adjectives blue in each sentence.</p>	<p>Create a word search puzzle using 'ou' and 'ow' words e.g. house, proud. List the words underneath that have to be found in the puzzle.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Solve- John had 29 letters to deliver to four houses. The first house got 5 letters, the third one got two more than the first. How many did the other houses get? Remember there is more than one correct answer and show how you worked it out.</p>	<p>Choose a times table you want to learn and write it out 3 times. Get someone to test you and write a comment about how you went next to them.</p>	<p>Draw 5 pictures of symmetrical objects and draw in the lines of symmetry e.g. an apple, a leaf</p>
<p>General</p>	<p>Make a card and write a message in it for someone you care about. After you get it back from your teacher, give it to the person.</p>	<p>Build an interesting structure out of lego or blocks or even playing cards. Name it, take a photo and paste it in you book.</p>	<p>Design a poster telling people ways to help look after our planet. You could include ways to save water & electricity, recycle, reduce and reuse.</p>
