

SWIMMING and WATER SAFETY PROGRAM

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Dear Parents,

As part of the Health and Physical Education curriculum, students in **Foundation to Year 3** will be attending a swimming and water safety program. This year the program for the Junior and Middle School will be held at Kings Langwarrin Park Swimming Pool, located at Langwarrin Park Primary School. The pool is 18m, indoor and heated, and boasts a state-of-the-art filtration system ensuring premium water quality for the swimmers. The program caters for all abilities and is taken in small groups by fully qualified instructors.

Students will attend 6 sessions in October, the lesson duration will be 45 minutes.

**Dates are: Monday: 15 October, 22 October & 29 October 2018
Wednesday: 17 October, 24 October & 31 October 2018**

The Swimming in Schools initiative has allocated funding to Cranbourne South Primary School which allows the school to offer students a discounted cost to the 2018 water safety and swimming program.

The cost of the program is \$76.50 for six lessons which includes entrance fees, tuition fees, swimming cap and bus transport to and from the venue. A deposit of \$26.50 must be received by Friday, 21 September to guarantee a place in this swimming program. The balance can be paid by instalments, Instalment 1 of \$25 is due by Friday, 12 October and Instalment 2 of \$25 is due by Friday, 26 October 2018. Full payment must be received by Friday, 26 October 2018.
