As part of the Health and Physical Education curriculum, students in Year 5 & 6, will be attending a swimming and water safety program. This year the program will be held at Frankston Beach, 101 Wells Street Frankston
Tuesday, 18 December 2018.

The program will be run by fully qualified instructors from Life Saving Victoria. It will incorporate a series of water safety and beachside activities and caters for all abilities.

The cost of this program is \$16 per student.

The Swimming in Schools initiative has allocated funding to Cranbourne South Primary School which allows the school to offer students a discounted cost to the 2018 water safety and swimming program.

Participants would be required to bring the following items:

- Enclosed shoes
- Shorts
- Bathers
- Lunch and water bottle
- Rash vest, t-shirt or long sleeved shirt (**no tank tops**) to wear during the program
- Towel
- Broad brimmed hat (**no baseball caps**)
- SPF 30+ Sunscreen
- School uniform

**** Please be advised that Life Saving Victoria strongly recommends the use of enclosed shoes by all program participants whilst participating in these activities.** Thongs are therefore not advised.
