To ensure students and parents understand the supervision and yard duty responsibilities by staff.


Aims

Cranbourne South Primary School understands it holds a high standard of care in relation to students at school. Appropriate, well-organised and responsive supervision of students during class time, recess and lunch is an important aspect of keeping students safe at school. It also enables staff to identify and respond to possible risks at school as they arise.

All staff participate in Cranbourne South Primary School's yard duty roster and school supervision requirements and follow clear procedures for responding to accidents or incidents in the playground and learning areas.

Implementation

School staff are rostered on for yard duty before school, during recess, lunch and after school. School grounds are supervised before school from 8:45 - 9.00am in Area A. After school, staff supervise Area A from 3.30 - 3:45pm. Students on school grounds outside these times will **not** be supervised (unless they attend a before or after school care program or supervised extracurricular activity).
