



Dear Families,

Home Learning in the Middle School will begin this year with the sole expectation of students reading daily at home.

Reading aloud and discussing what they read will improve your child's reading accuracy, fluency and comprehension.



Year Two students should read for at least 10 minutes a day and Year 3 and 4 students at least 15 and 20 minutes respectively. Reading diaries need to be filled in accurately to reflect students' reading commitment.

Students may access online educational programs being used in the classroom to supplement their home learning as they choose. Currently the programs being used are Seesaw, Mathletics, Soundwaves and Reading Eggs.

Later this term our spelling program will also be supported with some home learning tasks as will our teaching of automatic recall of number facts and times tables.

We will inform you of these initiatives and any other home learning requirements as they are introduced.
