



Enrolling Your Child in a Casey South Government Primary School

Enrolment Process for Casey South Government Primary Schools

Pre-schools and primary schools in the Casey South area recommend that you consider the advice below when enrolling your child in a local school. This will ensure that your chosen school can best plan for your child, and all students enrolled at the school.

We care for your child's education and view the enrolment process as a partnership between you the parent or guardian, your child's pre-school and the primary school. Our aim is to make the transition from pre-school to primary school a rewarding and satisfying process.

The Enrolment Process:

1. To be enrolled in a government primary school in 2021 a **child must turn five years of age on or before 30th April, 2021**. Speak to your pre-school teacher if you have any concerns about your child's readiness for school.
2. Information from your local primary schools will be available in your pre-school setting **late in Term Two**.
3. To assist you in finding your local neighbourhood government primary school go to www.findmyschool.vic.gov.au
4. Contact the school to get information. *In 2020, due to COVID-19 restrictions, schools will not be running face-to-face or onsite tours. They may provide videos, virtual tours or other alternatives. Parents will need to contact individual schools to get details.*
5. Most primary schools offer **Transition Programs** during the year so that pre-school children become familiar with the school setting prior to the start of the Prep year. *Any transition programs will not start until later in term 3 and there may be restrictions due to COVID-19.*
6. Parents are advised that enrolments in Casey South primary schools are due by **Friday 31st August, 2020**. Enrolment Forms are available from your local school. If you consider that your child may be eligible for funding for a disability or impairment, it is important to mention this to the Principal or enrolment officer at the time of enrolment.
7. Prior to commencing school, you must produce documentary evidence of **Date of Birth and a completed Immunisation Certificate**. In some cases, both of these may not be available until nearer the time of commencing school. Don't delay enrolment if you are still waiting for completion of an Immunisation Certificate. This can be handed to the school later in the year.
8. ***Please note that you may only enrol your child in one school. Dual enrolments will not be accepted.***

For your convenience, you will find overleaf, a list of government primary schools in the Casey South area with the name of the school Principal and the school telephone number. Please note that some schools will direct you to an enrolment officer or coordinator rather than the Principal.

Transition from pre-school to primary school is an exciting and special time. We hope you enjoy the process and we look forward to assisting you in this venture.
