RESPECT FOR SCHOOL STAFF POLICY

Purpose

Cranbourne South Primary School (CSPS) will ensure that all members of staff and the community understand the schools expectations for appropriate interactions with school staff.

Scope

Staff at CSPS, including teachers, education support staff, office staff, the assistant Principal/s and Principal are committed to providing a supportive learning environment for all our students. All staff at CSPS have a right to a safe and supportive work environment.

CSPS expects that all parents/carers and visitors to our school behave in an appropriate and respectful manner to school staff at all times.

There will be a zero tolerance approach to any aggression, intimidation, threats or harassment of school staff, by any means (e.g. in person, by phone, by email, on social media etc). These behaviours may lead to exclusion from school grounds and school activities.

The Principal may report aggressive, intimidating, threatening or otherwise inappropriate conduct to Victoria Police. The Department of Education and Training may also take legal or other appropriate action against community members or parents/carers who pose a threat to the safety and wellbeing of school staff.

CSPS expects all members of our community to act consistently with our <u>Statement of Values and School Philosophy Policy</u>. We are committed to ensuring that staff, parents/carers and students are able to work together in an appropriate and respectful way.
