



Swimming Trials - Division qualification

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Please read the important information with regards to the optional C.S.P.S swimming time trials for students in Year 4, 5 and 6 only.

This event is only for students who are **strong** swimmers (can swim 50 metres of the selected stroke without stopping, holding onto lane ropes or feet touching the bottom of the pool). This will be predominantly students who currently attend swimming lessons and/or are capable of swimming 50 metres of a selected stroke.

Times will be recorded and compared with schools within our District along with times from the 2021 Casey South Divisional carnival to determine if qualification for the 2022 Casey South Division carnival is successful.

Date:	Tuesday, 22 February 2022
Venue:	Pines Forest Aquatic Centre, Forest Drive, Frankston North. Students will be swimming in a 50 metre outdoor pool.
Time:	4.30pm - 5.30pm <i>*Please ensure children arrive on time and are prepared to stay for the entire duration.</i>
Transport:	Parents/guardians are responsible for getting students to and from the venue. Parents/guardians must also stay and supervise for the duration of the time trials.
Cost:	There is no cost to attend the trials.
Due:	Please fill out the CSPS Swimming Trial Nomination Form to secure your spot by Wednesday, 16 February 2022. This is essential as it helps with planning of the event.
What to bring:	Students should bring the following items: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Swimmers- Towel- Sunscreen- Drink bottle (refillable)- Goggles (optional)- Swim cap (optional)
Other information:	Mrs Danielle Curtois will be running the time trials. Please note some staff will be in attendance however parents/guardians are responsible for their children whilst at the venue. This includes supervision when they are in the pool. Please ensure you have completed the CSPS Swimming Trial Nomination Form by Friday, 18 February 2022. No late nominations will be accepted.
