



## Swimming & Water Safety Program - Foundation, Year 1 & Year 2

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of the Health and Physical Education curriculum, students in **Foundation, Year 1 & Year 2** will be attending a swimming and water safety program.

<b>Event Information:</b>	Students will attend 8 forty five minute lessons at Casey RACE in small groups run by fully qualified instructors. The program caters for all abilities and it is strongly recommended that all students attend.
<b>Date:</b>	Students will attend 8 sessions each being 45 minutes in duration. - Monday, 22 August                      - Tuesday, 23 August, - Wednesday, 24 August                - Thursday, 25 August - Monday, 29 August                      - Tuesday, 30 August - Wednesday, 31 August                - Thursday, 1 September
<b>Venue:</b>	Casey RACE, 65 Berwick-Cranbourne Road, Cranbourne East
<b>Time:</b>	TBA - Timetable to be shared closer to the event.
<b>Transport:</b>	Students will be travelling in a seat belted bus to and from Casey RACE.
<b>Cost:</b>	The Swimming in Schools initiative has allocated funding to Cranbourne South Primary School which allows the school to offer students a discounted cost to the 2022 Water Safety and Swimming program. <i>We are fortunate to have enough funds to cover the whole program at <b>no charge to families</b>.</i>
<b>Permission:</b>	Permission via <b>QKR</b> is due by <b>Wednesday, 3 August 2022</b> *No late permission will be accepted as numbers need to be confirmed.
<b>What to bring:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <u>Students will need to ensure they have their swimmers on underneath their school uniform</u></li> <li>- They should pack a small bag containing their towel, goggles, swimming cap (optional), change of underwear and thongs/slides</li> <li>- Please make sure all belongings are clearly labeled and students are capable of getting themselves dressed</li> </ul>
<b>Other information:</b>	Please find attached a swimming ability survey from Casey RACE. This has to be completed and returned by <b>Wednesday, 3 August 2022</b> *No late surveys will be accepted as numbers need to be confirmed. *Please note your child's place is only <b>confirmed once permission and survey are received</b> .
<b>Spectators:</b>	Parents and spectators are allowed to attend. Please abide by the current DHS advice regarding COVID. Please note no parents/spectators will be allowed in the change rooms.
