Time:	Students will depart school at 9am and return at approximately 3pm
Cost:	The Swimming in Schools initiative has allocated funding to Cranbourne South Primary School which allows the school to offer students a discounted cost to the 2022 Water Safety and Swimming program. <i>We are fortunate to have enough funds to cover the whole program at no charge to families this year.</i>
Permission to attend:	Permission to attend this event must be given via QKR and is due by Wednesday, 23 November 2022 *No late permission will be accepted.
Transport:	Students will be traveling in a seat belted bus to Frankston
