

## i sea i care Ambassadors - Role description

<b>What being an i sea i care ambassador involves:</b>	Being an i sea i care ambassador includes your child participating in a wide range of opportunities to learn about the wonderful marine environment that we live so close to, as well as developing their leadership and teaching skills as they share their learning with the rest of the Cranbourne South community.
<b>Locations:</b>	<p>Excursions include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The chance to observe and swim with dolphins and seals, leaving from Sorrento on the Moonraker*</li> <li>• The chance to observe seals at Seal Rocks, leaving from Stoney Point</li> <li>• A coastal workshop</li> <li>• Observation opportunities at Frog Hollow Reserve</li> </ul> <p><i>*The Moonraker boat excursions to observe the dolphins and seals gives the students the opportunity to get in the water and therefore they should be confident in the water.</i></p>
<b>Other requirements:</b>	Tasks in school may include preparing and delivering assembly items, running a regular page in the school iNewsletter and fundraising to support the Dolphin Research Institute who run the i sea i care program in schools.
<b>Cost:</b>	\$20-\$25 per student per boat trip (cost may vary depending on the event) <i>Cranbourne South Primary School will partly subsidise the cost where possible.</i>
<b>Permission:</b>	Permission and/or payment to attend will be required via QRK as per current event procedures.
<b>Transport:</b>	Students will be transported to and from the event in the private vehicle of a nominated Cranbourne South Primary School staff member, in a vehicle covered by fully comprehensive car insurance.
