Take the dog for a walk or feed the cat. Do a doggie mess pick up in the yard! (No photos, thanks:)) Keep a record of how often you help with the pet.</p>	<p>Gardening Mow the lawn. Pull out some weeds or trim some bushes. Make sure you have permission first. Include before and after photos in your report.</p>
<p>Family Time Play a board game as a family. It can be a favorite, maybe monopoly or scrabble? Write about who played and the scores.</p>	<p>Wash the Car Wash the car for your parents, grandparents or family friend. Clean inside too. Take a before and after photo. Write a report including the type of car and how long it took.</p>	<p>Do a favour Do someone a favour. Be helpful and unselfish. Write an account of what you did and who you did it for.</p>
<p>Write a Review Watch a movie or television show and write a review about it. Give it a rating and recommendation. (G or PG rated please)</p>	<p>Mathletics Earn yourself a certificate in Mathletics. Go for Gold!!!</p>	<p>Clean Up. Surprise your Mum by cleaning up your room. Make the bed and put everything away. Take before and after photos to share. Write a report of what you had to do and the reaction you got.</p>
